Bar Hill Village Green

Adopted 2018, reviewed 2019; amended July 2022

Village Greens were defined by the Commons Registration Act of 1965 as land allotted by their owners or locality for the exercise or recreation of its inhabitants or for the right to indulge in lawful sports or pastimes.

Bar Hill organisations wishing to use the Village Green or any part of it must have the prior written permission of the Parish Council after showing Risk Assessment and valid insurance documentation. Under no circumstances may the Village Green be used for commercial events.

The Village Green must be left in a clean and tidy condition with any damage restored at the user's cost.

All users of the Village green will be required to register the dates and times of their use on the Parish Council's Village green calendar. The Calendar is operated on a first requested basis, unless there are extraordinary circumstances.

In such instances any concerns/disputes over the Calendar should be referred to the Parish Council for a final resolution. The calendar may be altered or amended at the sole discretion of the Parish Council.
